Font and Type Sizes:

- **Title:** 14 point, bold, capital letters, Times New Roman
- **Authors' Names:** 12 point, bold
- **Affiliations:** 12 point, regular
- **Abstract Text:** 12 point, Times New Roman
- **Keywords:** 12 point, italic

Text Formatting:

- Single-spaced throughout
- Left and right justified
- Abstract structured with bold headings: Background, Purpose/Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusions

Word Limits:

- **Extended Abstract:** Between 1,500 and 2,500 words (including all text, excluding title, authors, affiliations, abstract, keywords, and references)
- **Abstract:** Maximum 200 words
- **Keywords:** Maximum 5 keywords
- **References:** Typically 3-6 key sources (not counted in word limit)
